Option/Elective Waitlists

Half Year Courses:

- If there are scheduling conflicts or you do not meet the pre-requisites, you will not be removed from the waitlist

Full Year Courses (Electives):

- Must enroll in the same section for Fall and Winter
 - Must enroll in the A and B section of courses
- If full at the time of your enrolment appointment, check after reserves are lifted on July 26th
- No waitlists for full-year courses.

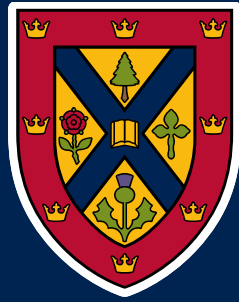
